

Southminster Nursery School Registration Guide

Registration will begin on Monday, January 26th. We will follow, to some extent, a natural progression. All in-house families are welcome to turn registration forms in beginning **Monday, January 26th**.

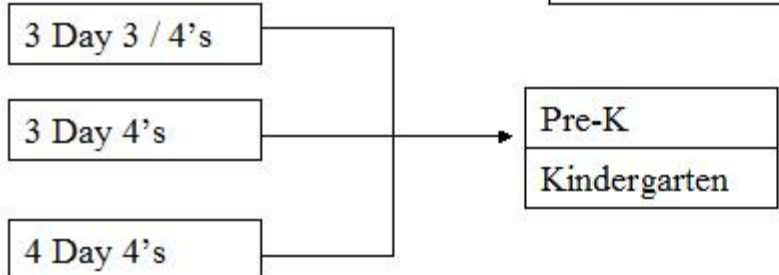
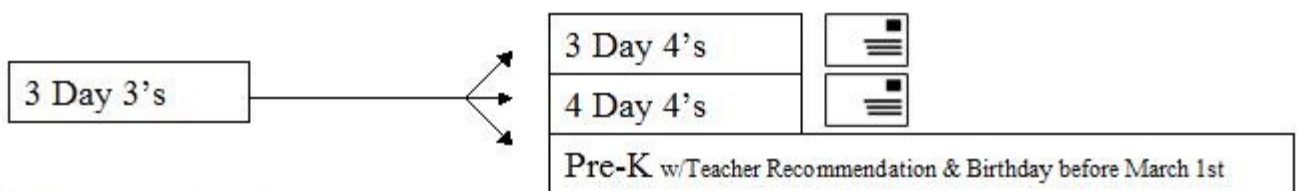
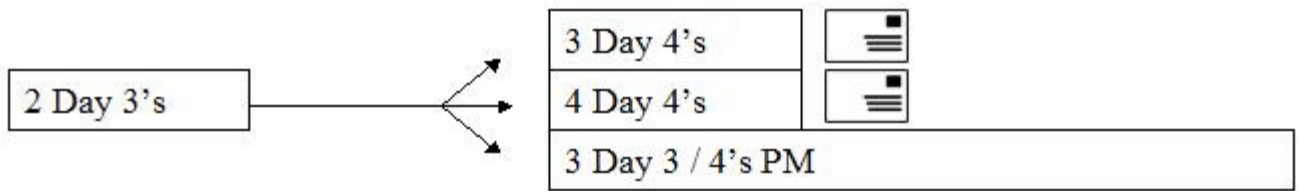
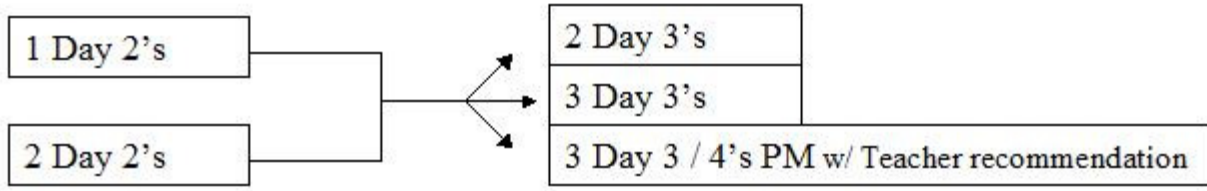
- The 1-day 2's class and the 2-day 2's classes will progress to the 3-day 3's or, if both you and your teacher feel another class is more suitable for your child they may move to the 2-day 3's or the pm 3 / 4's class.
- The 2-day 3's classes will progress to the afternoon 3 / 4's class, 3-day 4's class, or the 4-day 4's class.
- The 3-day 3's classes will progress to the 3-day 4's class or the 4-day 4's class, or the Pre-K classes. Progression to the Pre-K class will require a teacher recommendation. Also, the 3 day 3's classes (with the above mentioned teacher recommendation and/or birthday before March 1st), 3 day 4's class, the afternoon 3 / 4's class, and the 4 day 4's class are eligible to register for the Pre-K classes.
- **Both the 3-day 4's class and the 4 day 4's class will require a mail-in registration that must be postmarked on, but not before Thursday, January 29th.**

The Four –year- old classes are the only classes that will require a mail in registration with the postmark of January 29th. All other classes may be registered by simply dropping your registration form off in the basket provided in my office. First choices are almost guaranteed in all but the Four year old programs. Confirmations will be sent home before open registration begins on Wednesday, February 4th. Siblings of previously enrolled students may register beginning Monday, February 2nd, as well as church members. Children enrolled in Southminster Child Care may register beginning Tuesday, February 3rd. All registration will be open to the public beginning Wednesday, February 4th. Registration forms will be put in all your boxes by Friday January 16th and will also be available on the website on or shortly before that date, as well.

Please remember, all in-house students are guaranteed a spot in the program. The only situation that could arise is that perhaps you may not get your first choice where the 4-day 4's class is concerned. If the 4-day 4's class is your first choice please keep a few things in mind. First, be sure to make a second choice, that choice is guaranteed. Second, be sure to mail your registration form in and have it postmarked on January 29th and no earlier. Please also note all first choices are always honored during in house registration for all other programs. The only class where a second choice will be used is the 4-day 4's class.
